

Menno Saunders, 166½, Berensford, S. D., vs. Harold Anderson, 166½, Laurel Neb. The referee—Harry Gibbons.

ROUND 1—Anderson shook Saunders with a left but Saunders hooked rights and lefts to the face. They slugged wildly to the face and body. Saunders was short with a right and as they missed rights, they slipped to the canvas together. Anderson evaded a left. Saunders jabbed a left and they stood in a corner and slugged both hands to the face. Anderson smashed rights and lefts to the face and drove Saunders to the ropes, where he went down in a corner for a count of three. Saunders was short with a left but he hooked rights and lefts to the face. They started slugging wildly again and Anderson dropped Saunders again for a count of nine. Anderson drove both hands to the face and they started to slug again. Saunders was short with a left. Anderson was short with a left but a booming overhand right dropped Saunders to one knee just before the bell.

ROUND 2—They came out slowly. Anderson drove both hands to the head and he flashed rights and lefts to the head. They slugged fiercely along the ropes and went into a clinch. Saunders hooked a right to the face. Saunders was short with a left but he scored with a left and a right. Saunders spun Anderson half around with a right. Anderson caught a succession of rights to the head, then clinched. They moved slowly in midring. Saunders missed a looping right. Saunders was short with a left. Anderson clipped a left to the body and a right to the face and dropped Saunders for a count of seven. Anderson rushed back in but Saunders tied him up in a clinch. Anderson slipped to one knee. They moved cautiously but Saunders shot an overhand right that landed lightly on Anderson's head.

ROUND 3—Saunders slipped just after the round began. Saunders tagged Anderson with a hard right but the Laurel kid came smashing in with overhand rights and lefts. They stood in a corner and slugged briefly. Anderson caught one in the body. Anderson missed an overhand right and they fell into a clinch. Anderson clipped a short right to the head. Anderson was wild with a right. Saunders jabbed a left to the face. Both were tiring. Anderson was wild with a right but he tied up Saunders in a clinch. Saunders shot a straight right to the head. Anderson ducked into a right and slipped to the canvas as he caught a left. They began slugging again along the ropes but both were arm weary and neither did much damage.

The winner—Harold Anderson by a decision.
