GLENN ELIAS POCOCK



Glenn was born on August 5, 1864 in Rock Bluff, Nebraska according to his death certificate and obituary. Glenn was the second of seven children born to John Wharton Pocock and Lucina Patterson.

I have very few records or stories, for Glenn, and will put together what I have.

We first see him in the 1870 Federal Census with his parents in Rock Bluffs, Nebraska. Glenn is again with his parents in the 1880 Federal Census in Rock Bluffs.

By 1885 the Pocock family has moved and we see Glenn with his family, reporting through the 1885 Nebraska Census in Nemaha, Nebraska

Between 1885 and 1894 Glenn has moved again as he married Ada Blanche Albright on Jan 21, 1894 in Nance County, Nebraska as listed in the Nebraska Marriage Records.

In 1899 the US Index County Land Ownership Maps show that Glenn owns 80 acres in Township 16N, Range 4W in section 17. He has half of the SW quarter.

The 1900 Federal Census is the first time Glenn is listed with his own family. He is listed in District 0148, Prairie Creek, Nance, Nebraska. He lists his occupation as a farmer and that he owns his home.

The 1910 Federal Census shows Glenn with his family in District 0162, Prairie Creek, Nance, Nebraska. At this time he and Ada list that they have 7 children and all 7 are still living. His occupation is farmer. A census district change does not indicate a physical move, and I believe these two census records are the same physical address.

The 1920 Federal Census has Glenn with his family now in a new location, District 0258, North Loup, Valley, Nebraska. They list 8 children living at home, and that they rent their home. Glenn still lists his occupation as a farmer.

By 1930 Glenn and his family have moved further west. We now see them listed in District 0005, Chase, Keith, Nebraska. Glenn states that he is renting his home and his occupation is farming. The family notes that they do own a radio set. There are 5 children living at home.

In 1940, the last census available today, Glenn is in 51-5, Chase, Keith, Nebraska and at age 75 still lists his occupation as farming. Their son Harley and daughter in law Hazel are living with them. Glenn and Ada are living in the same house they were in in 1935. Glenn leaves blank the field for highest level of education and Ada lists that she has completed through the 8th grade.

The only other piece of information I have for Glenn is that he died on May 6, 1964 in Ogallala, Nebraska according to his death certificate and is buried in the Big Springs, Nebraska Cemetery.

Glenn and Ada

Ada was born on October 21, 1876 in Dekalb County, Indiana according to her death certificate. She was the oldest of three girls born to Charles Albright and Helen Clutter. There are some sources that have a child who died young between Ada and her next sister. The 1910 census also states that there were four children born, three living, but I don't have details on deceased sibling.

In the 1880 Federal Census Ada is living with her parents in Gratiot County Michigan.

I don't have many other details on Ada's family before her marriage to Glenn in 1894. I do have her parents and siblings in Merrick County, Nebraska by the 1900 census.

Her obituary does state that she was born in Auburn, Indiana, the family lived in Michigan for a time, and then came to Nebraska in 1890.

Ada died on June 12, 1955 in Genoa, Nebraska while visiting family as stated in her obituary and on her death certificate. Ada is buried in the Big Springs, Nebraska Cemetery.
